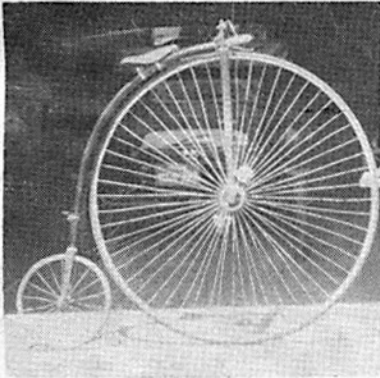


Sign of the Sick Jackass Clamper Goesch Is In Need!

Clamper Garland R. Goesch writes that he is in need of a high wheel bike (like the picture) to ride in parades and other events to help promote Big Brothers of Modesto.

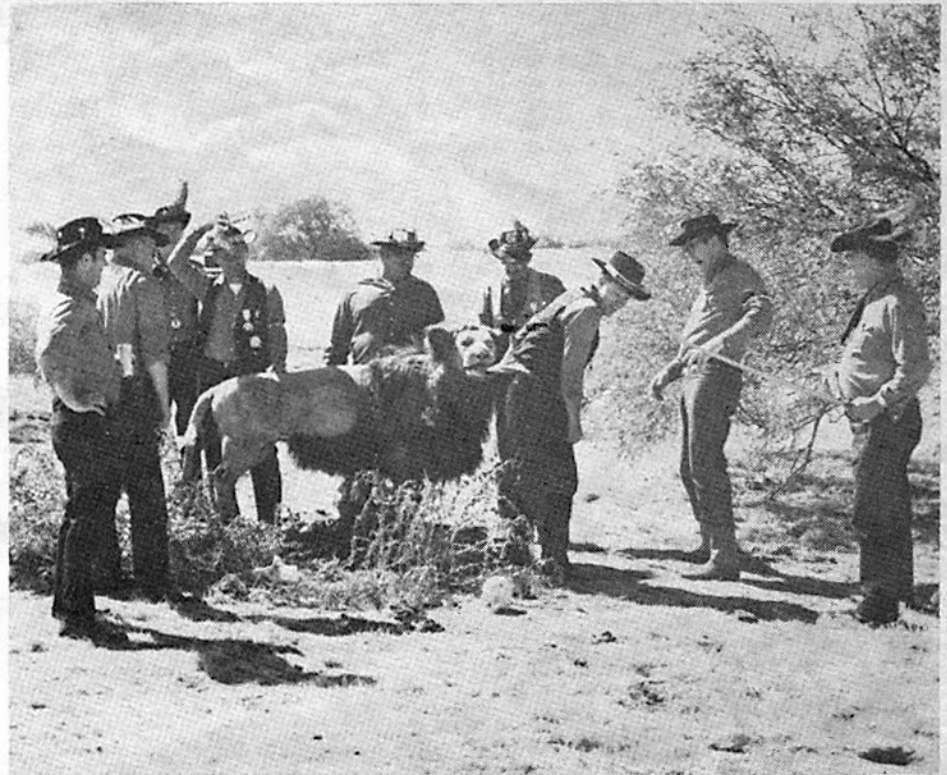
