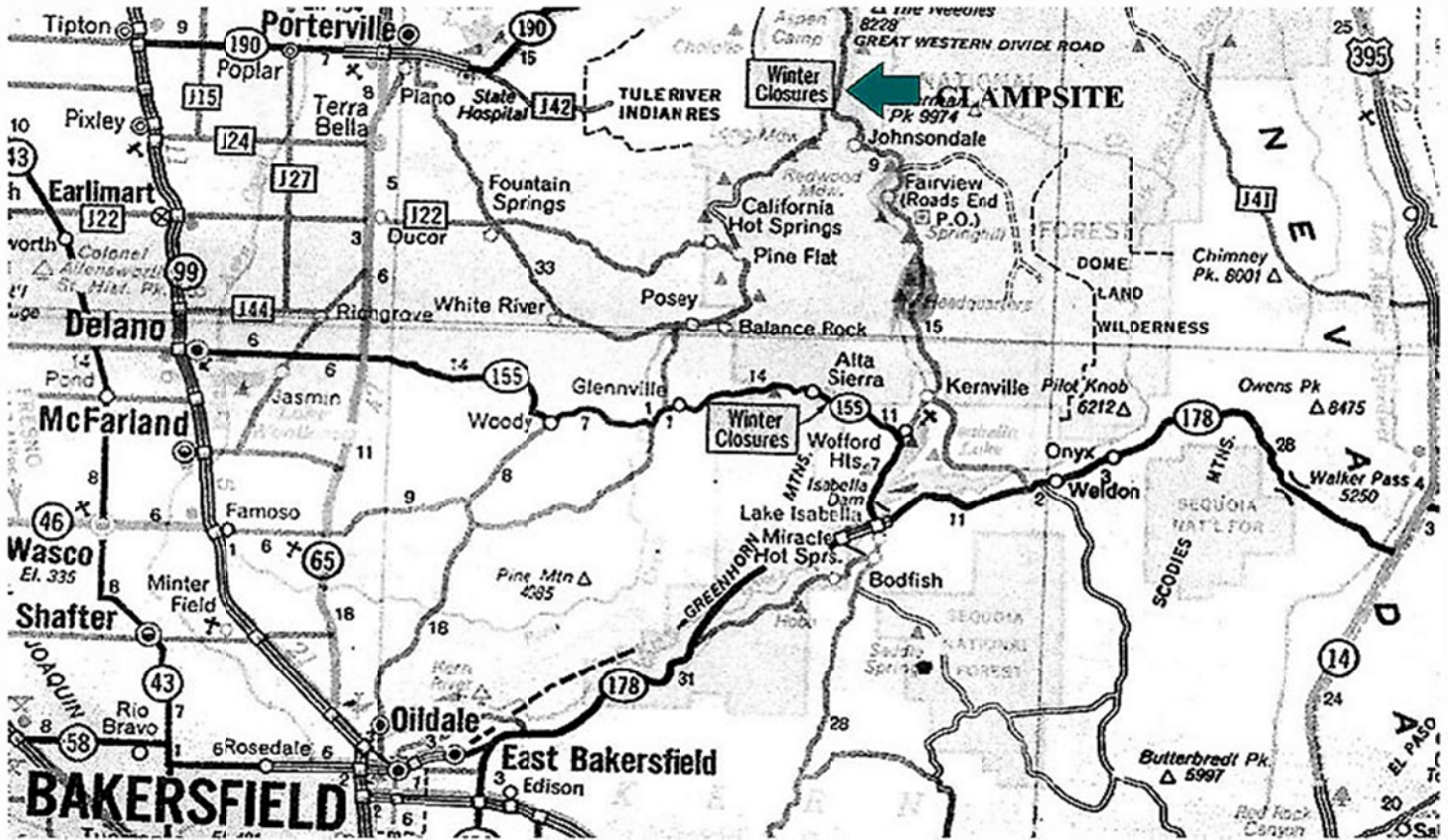

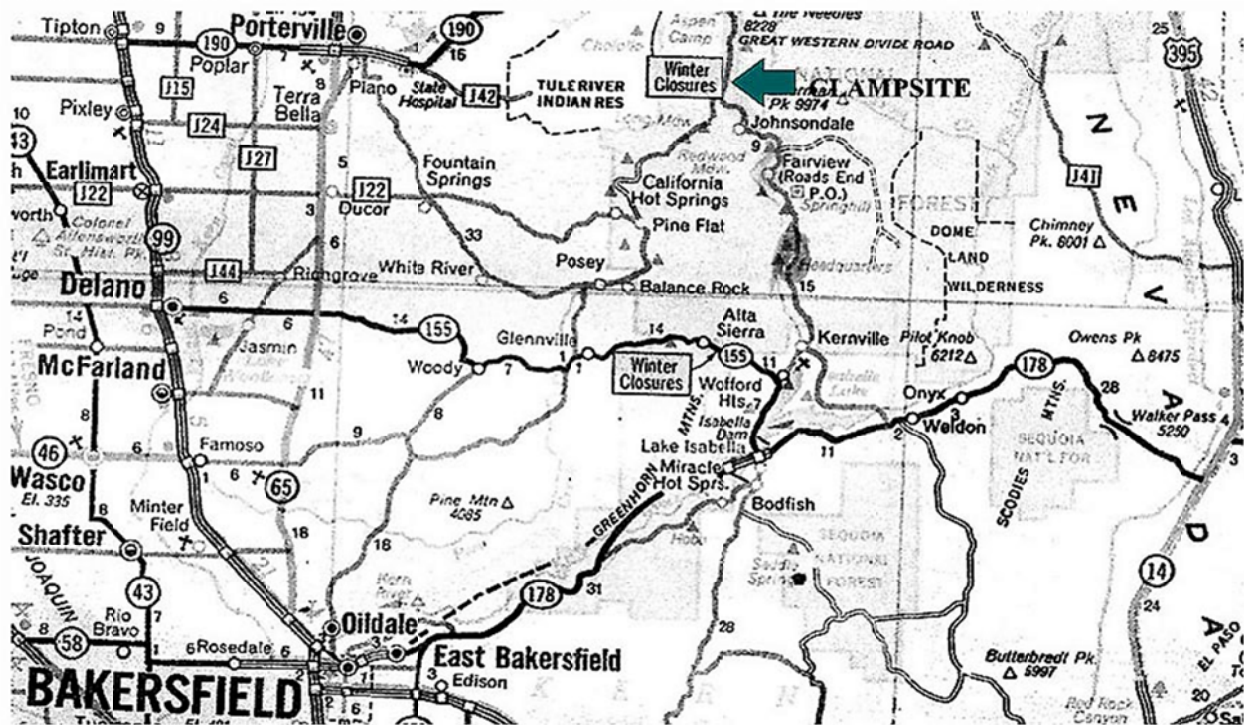

## Directions to the Peter Lebeck Fall 2010 Clampout at “Clamp Whitsett”

Beginning Friday Morning, October 15th, 2010, you are welcome to join us at Camp Whitsett in the Sequoia National Monument. These are the directions.

If you are coming from the north along Highway 99: You'll want to get off Highway 99 at Earlimart. Then take the Kern 122 east to Mountain Road 50. Head north on M50 until it intersects with Mountain Road 99 where you will turn left (north). Camp Whitsett is about three miles down this road, but make sure to stay to your right when you reach the next fork. The **paved** entrance to the Camp Whitsett will be on your right.



Everybody else will want to follow these directions -- so read carefully!

Your best approach to the Clampsite will be from the south, taking Highway 178 to Lake Isabella, then Highway 55 and Burlando Road north into Kernville, and finally the mountain roads up into the forest. Highway 178 is also known as Lake Isabella Highway and is accessible from the west by taking Highway 99, and from the east by taking Highway 14. So....

If you are coming from Bakersfield or from the south on Highway 99, take Highway 178 east to the town of Lake Isabella, then head north into Kernville. This western approach is through a narrow canyon so if you are coming from Los Angeles or Orange Counties, especially if you have an RV, you're best bet is to avoid the Grapevine and the 99 altogether. Instead take Highway 14 north, which will take you through the Antelope Valley and the town of Mojave, and connect to Highway 178 from the east.

## Direction to the doins:

GPS co-ordinates: 36° 0' 19" N, 118° 32' 14" W .

FROM THE SOUTH : Take Hwy 178 (from either Bakersfield or Hwy 14) to Lake Isabella. Follow the highway to Kernville. Go north out of Kernville, about 28 miles. The "R" Ranch will be to your left. Go for several hundred yards until you come to a fork. The main road will curve up to the left, TAKE THE RIGHT HAND FORK, Forest road 22S82. Continue for about three miles. You will cross three bridges over three streams, and will pass three campsites: Campground 1, 2 & 3. The road will curve sharply to the right a short distance past campsite 3. Whitsett's entrance is just beyond this curve, on the right. FROM THE NORTH: Go south on Highway 99 to J22, the DUCOR exit. Go east through DUCOR and wind up through California Hot Springs and on toward Johnsondale. You will travel over Parker Pass, passed the Western Divide highway turnoff, and down, once again, toward Johnsondale. Near the bottom of the road, you will see a turnoff to the left onto 22S82. This Forest road is the turnoff mentioned above (if you get to the "R" Ranch, Johnsondale, turn back). Continue for about three miles. You will cross three bridges over three streams - and will pass three campsites: Campground 1, 2 & 3. The road will curve sharply to the right a short distance past campsite 3. Whitsett's entrance is just beyond this curve, on the right.
