CHAPTER NOTES

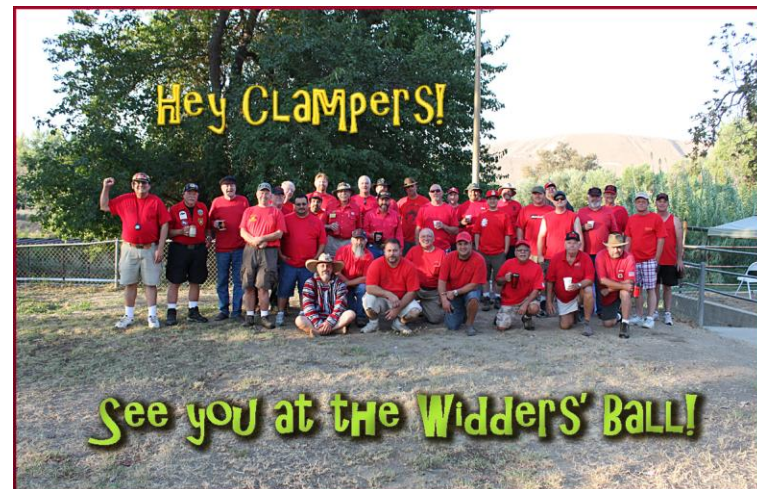
