# **NO THURSDAY ARRIVALS**

### **Directions from Bakersfield:**

Take 178 East to Elizabeth Norris (Exit 42 towards Bodfish) at the bottom of the off ramp turn Right. Turn Right on Lake Isabella Blvd., Lake Isabella becomes Caliente Bodfish Road. Continue about 3 ½ miles and look for Bald Eagle Ranch Sign at the bottom of the "S" curve. You have reached 2021 Clear Creek Road, Bald Eagle Ranch.



#### From Tehachapi – Mojave – LA:

Take SR 58 to the Caliente exit. Go north through Caliente for about five miles until you reach a fork in the Road, keep right onto Caliente Creek Road. You will pass the community of Twin Oaks and the road will now become Walker Basin Road. When you reach Walker Basin Rd at Walker Basin Rd continue West until you reach Johns Rd. Stay on the asphalt road until you reach Caliente Bodfish Road (Approx 1.5 miles) then turn right. Continue through the town of Havilah. The Bald Eagle Ranch is about 2 miles from the Havilah Court House at the beginning of the "S" curve.

Note: Coming from Mojave or LA the Lions Trail (Caliente Bodfish Road) is about 30 minutes closer <u>BUT IS NOT</u> recommended for Motor homes and trailers.

#### SUPPORT THE BAKERSFIELD SHELTER

Please remember to bring personal items for the ladies and their kids at the shelter. They need soap, shampoo, conditioner, sanitary napkins, combs, rushes, toothpaste, toothbrushes, etc. Some school supplies for the kids would be nice too. It's good for them and good for you! No food items, please.
