Directions from Bakersfield:

Take 58 East. Take exit 148 for CA-202 toward Tehachapi Turn right onto CA-202 West /Tucker Road. Continue to follow CA-202 W/ Tucker Rd. Turn right onto CA-202 W / Valley Blvd. Turn left onto Banducci Road and watch for Brite Lake Entrance Sign on right. We will be located by Pavilion 3



From Mojave – LA and all points south:

I-5 North - Take exit 162 CA-14 North toward Palmdale.

Take exit 61 for Backus Road. Make a sharp left onto Backus Rd. Continue 7.6 miles.

Turn right on Tehachapi Willow Springs Road - Drive 13.8 miles

Turn left onto Highline Rd—Drive 7.1 miles

Turn left onto Banducci Road Entrance look for the Brite Lake Sign entrance on the right.
