A Word from the Humbug Rick "Hardluck" Veiga

Howdy to my brothers of red and black! We have a great Spring dedication planned for the weekend of April 10th, 11th and 12th leaving on the morning of the 13th. **The Spring Doins is limited to 100 Clampers.**

Where is this swaray ?(that's French talk for a "Doins" taught to me by old Peter Lebeck himself!)

Well boys, we are going to the mining town of Randsburg to dedicate one of the oldest businesses in the town's history known presently as "The Joint".

This historic building first served as a Steam Bakery owned and operated by Henry Rott a German immigrant who was a baker and confectioner in Randsburg from 1898 to 1904. In 1904 Henry Rott sold one half of his business to a Mrs. W. O. (Martha) Lidy .

In 1905 they purchased an Edison Heating and Lighting Plant for the bakery in what now houses "THE JOINT". Our PXL brother, Neil Shotwell Jr. and his Widder are the 3rd generation owners of this establishment and plenty excited about having E Clampus Vitus, Peter Lebeck Chapter 1866 dedicating the location.

Our brother Neil also owns a property in nearby Johannesburg previously used as the elementary school where we will be clampin in the lap of luxury. We will have room for RVs and tent camping along with an indoor area for both eating and socializing out of the elements plus downtown Randsburg is only about a mile away!

So, get your rub and registration before we hit the **limit of 100 brothers**. If you cannot make the weekend, come up on Saturday 12th at 10AM for the dedication at "The Joint".

WE'RE TRYING SOMETHING NEW

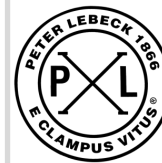

How Do I Get There?

The actual Clampsite is in Johannesburg at what was formerly “The Rand School.”



From Bakersfield: Take CA-58 through the Tehachapi Pass then take exit 167. Turn left onto CA-14 east and go about 17.5 miles to exit onto Redrock Randsburg RD. Travel 12 miles to a fork in the road then keep right. At another 8.4 miles take the left fork to stay on Redrock Randsburg RD. then follow it to US-395 and turn right. Continue 1 mile to St. Elmo ST and turn right. The Clampsite is 6 blocks down on your left.

GPS Coordinates 35°22'04.5"N 117°38'08.7"W

From L.A. and Santa Clarita: Take CA-14 north. If you are coming from L.A. take the I-5 north and transition onto CA-14 as you enter the Newhall Pass. From Santa Clarita just take CA-14 north.

Once on CA-14, drive past Lancaster for another 24 miles to Mojave. At Mojave you will drive down a bridge where the 14 freeway transitions into a surface street. Go another 1.3 miles and turn right onto CA-14, then another 20 miles to exit onto Redrock Randsburg RD. Travel 12 miles to a fork in the road then keep right. At another 8.4 miles take the left fork to stay on Redrock Randsburg RD. then follow it to US-395 and turn right. Continue 1 mile to St. Elmo ST and turn right. The Clampsite is 6 blocks down on your left.
