ALL PBC's must have a bribe for the board and an historical presentation, as well as their dust.


REMEMBER - IT'S B.Y.O.B. Bring libations for yourself and others. The PXL bar has sodas.

If you take this route, make sure you have a lot of gas when you leave Hwy 58.
