ALL PBCs must have a bribe for the board and an historical presentation, as well as their dust.

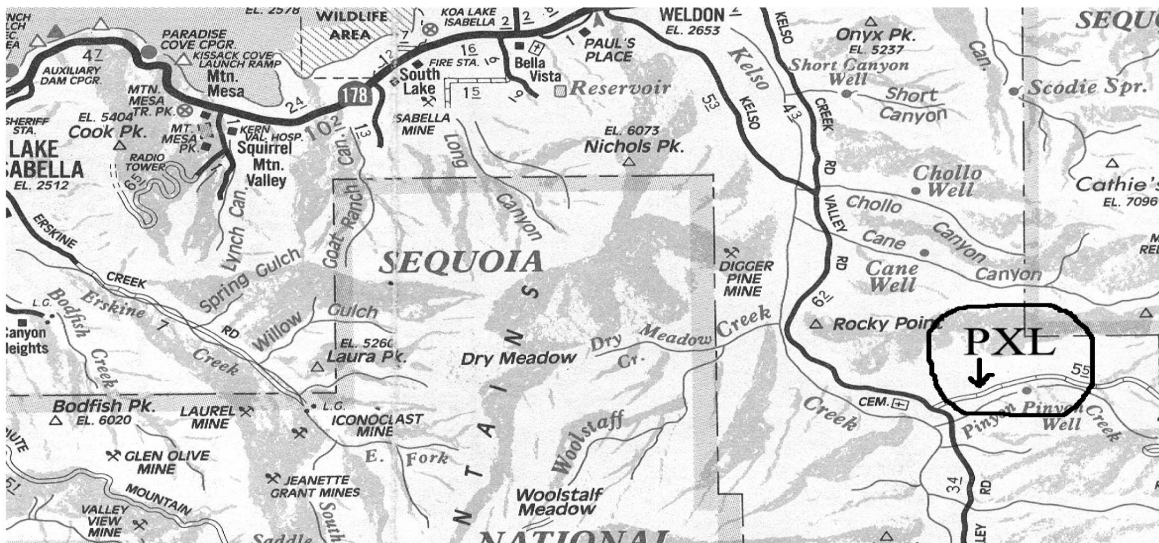
REMEMBER - IT'S B.Y.O.B. Bring libations for yourself and others. The PXL bar has mixers and ice.

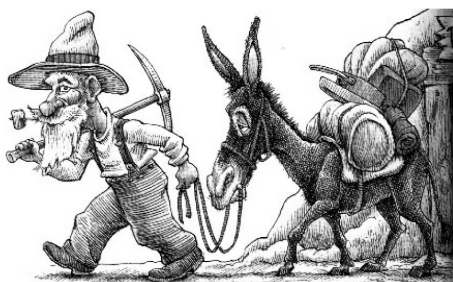
HOW TO GET THERE:
