

Take Hwy 178 east or west to the Bodfish exit. Turn right and take the Caliente-Bodfish Road south for 6.8 miles. The gate is on your right, just after the curve. OR, you can take Hwy 58 to the Caliente exit. Go north on the Caliente-Bodfish Road about 2 miles past the town of Havilah. The gate will be on the left. If you take this route, make sure you have a lot of gas when you leave Hwy 58.
