They need soap, shampoo, conditioner, sanitary napkins, combs, brushes, toothpaste, toothbrushes, etc. Some school supplies for the kids would be nice too. It's good for them and good for you! No food items, please.

Most of the time, this weekend will be spent in the seclusion of the Clampsite. But, during the three dedications, there may be civilians present. <u>Please</u> be on your best behavior, watch your language and show respect to the ladies and kids. Let's leave them with a good impression of ECV® & Peter Lebeck Chapter.
