No Dogs and Again, No Retreads!

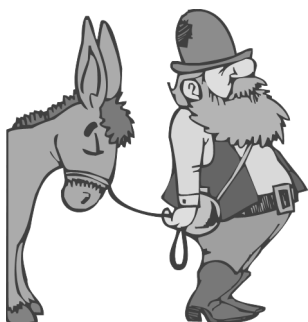
