## A Word from the Humbug Dave "Boulder" Staley

Welcome Brothers, Dave "Boulder Staley here, your new Humbug for the year 6031. This Clamp year 2026 is slated to be nothing but SATISFACTORY, here at PXL.

We will be heading back to the Randsburg/Johannesburg area for our spring doings on April 16th through the 19th to plaque the Rand District cemetery.

This cemetery was first established in 1897 with the burial of William Davis who was killed in a gambling dispute.

As described by the Rand Desert Museum:

**"Collected here are the final resting places of some five generations of dream chasers, miners, merchants, ranchers, freighters, madams, promoters, vigilantes, teachers, movers and shakers, loafers and busy bodies; most from somewhere else, from all over the world, all brought here by the winds of fortune, and caught, like nuggets, in holes in the ground."**

The cemetery is located a few blocks from our Clamp site at the old Rand school house owned by our PXL brother Neil Shotwell and his widder. Once again Neil has offered this location as Clamp central with an abundant indoor area for meals and other tomfoolery we seem to appreciate in 1866.

Those who attended the Spring doings last year are aware that the parking area at the school can be tight with many RVs. That being said, if we can reduce our individual footprint and buddy up in rigs that would be appreciated. 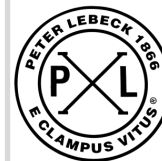
## Saturday Clamper Get Away

## How Do I Get To the Dang Doings?

As of this post, the REDROCK/RANDBURG ROAD is closed due to flood damage.

Do not take CA-14 out of Mojave to get to Johannesburg because you may have to turn around.

Use the following directions instead:



**From Bakersfield:** Take CA-58 east through the Tehachapi Pass to Kramer Junction (approx. 90 miles). Take exit 206 (the Bishop/San Bernardino off ramp). At the bottom of the ramp turn right on to US 395. Continue north for 27 miles. When you see the Texaco station on the left, turn left at the next intersection, which is Saint Elmo Street. The Rand School Clampsite will be on your left at the end of the pavement, about seven blocks up.

**From L.A. and SF Valley:** Take the I-5 north, as you approach the Newhall Pass, keep to your right and transition onto CA-14, then follow the direction for Santa Clarita.

**From Santa Clarita:** Take CA-14 north for approximately 68 miles, as you come off of the bridge and into Mojave, you will see a Fast Trip gas station on your right, turn right onto CA-58 business for 3.7 miles. Then turn right onto the CA-58 freeway east and go 32.5 to exit 206 (the Bishop/San Bernardino off ramp). At the bottom of the ramp turn right on to US 395. Continue north for 27 miles. When you see the Texaco station on the left, turn left at the next intersection, which is Saint Elmo Street. The Rand School Clampsite will be on your left at the end of the pavement, about seven blocks up.

## The school is next door to the Rand District Water District!
